

Qualifications to register to vote in North Carolina...

To register to vote in this State, a person must sign a voter declaration attesting that:

- ❖ I am a U.S. citizen.
- ❖ I have been a resident of North Carolina and this county for 30 days before the election.
- ❖ I will be at least 18 years old by the next general election.
- ❖ I am not registered, nor will I vote in any other county or state.
- ❖ If I have been convicted of a felony, my rights of citizenship have been restored.

How can I register to vote?

Anyone wishing to register to vote, who meets the above mentioned criteria, may obtain a voter registration application in one of the following ways:

- ❖ You may go directly to the State Board of Elections Website: <http://www.sboe.state.nc.us>? For a list of departments and agencies that distribute voter registration applications, or to download an application to mail in to your local Board of Elections office.
- ❖ You may come by our office and fill out a voter registration application.
- ❖ You may call our office and request a voter registration application by mailed to you.
- ❖ You may e-mail our office and request a voter registration application be mailed to you through regular mail.
- ❖ You may register to vote when you apply for, or renew, your driver's license at your local Department of Motor Vehicles Office (DMV).
- ❖ Your local libraries should have voter registration applications that you can complete and mail to your local Board of Elections office.
- ❖ The Department of Social Services and the Employment Security Commission offices should have voter registration applications that you may fill out and mail to your local Board of Elections office.
